CHILDREN'S HOME AT ADIVARAM

In 1993, DBAI Salem freely received land from the Government. The land is mainly donated for rehabilitate of the street boys. It caters to different types of children such as: Orphans, Semi Orphans, neglected children, abused children, children with substance abuseetc., whom we call "Children at Risk". One of our chief activities is running two Children's Homes at Mulluvadi gate and Yercaud Adivaram catering to about120Children. "The Children's Home at Adivaram" annually caters to around 100 children. It is registered under Juvenile Justice Care and Protection Act 2015. Nearly, 2500 children have been getting protection and care from DBAI Salem.

PURPOSE OF THE PROPOSAL

- The sustainable development goal (SDG) 6 is the water and sanitation. It is "to ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all", and targets to end open defecation. The current rates of progress even though the Inter-governmental Open Working Group on the Post-2015 Sustainable Development Goals have recommended that the new goals include a target of achieving "adequate and equitable sanitation and hygiene for all and ending open defecation by 2030". This is one of the reasons why the appeal to end the practice of open defecation is being made with growing insistence.
- The State Governments to ensure that sufficient Child Care Institutions (CCI) are established by integrated child protection scheme (ICPS) for Observation Home, Special Home and Place of Safety like"1 Toilet for 7 children, 1bathing room for 10 children".
- Improving access to sanitation is a critical step towards reducing the impact of these diseases. It also helps create physical environments that enhance safety, dignity and self-esteem. Safety issues are particularly important for children. The aim of the proposal is "To provide a safe, healthy and hygiene environment that will increase children's better sanitation and hygiene condition". The direct beneficiaries of the project are children who are staying in open shelter and children's home at Adivaram.

URGENT NEED

- Provision of 10 toilet and 10 bathing rooms for children. This will help to adhere to the requirements of "Minimum standards of care"
- The existing toilet block which is more than 20 years old and not able to use it.
- This will help in creating better health and hygiene environment.
- The organization is mobilizing and pooling resources for the same. It's an urgent need which needs attention. Hence, we make a special request to your esteemed concern for financial assistance for the same in full or partial.
