DBAI Adivaram was founded in 1997 by the Salesians and opened by District Collector Mr. Hansiraj Verma. Located in the beautiful foothills of Yercaud, Salem, we focus on helping children who have lost their parents, live on the streets, or are in difficult situations. We currently support 61 children at our two homes, the Children’s Home and Open Shelter, providing them with food, education, health care, and fun activities. Our goal is to give these children a safe place to live and help them reintegrate into their families when possible.

We expect 8 football teams to take part, with each team consisting of 10 players (7 players on the field and 3 substitutes).

4. Planning and Execution

To ensure the event runs smoothly, we will form the following teams:

- **Food and Refreshments Team:** Will provide meals and drinks for the players, referees, and participants.
- **Ceremony Team:** Will organize the opening and closing ceremonies, including inviting special guests.
- **Ground Team:** Will set up the football field, arrange the necessary equipment, and handle logistics on the day of the event.
- **First Aid Team:** Will offer medical support and emergency care.
- **Sound & Light Team:** Will manage the microphones and stage setup.
