

THERAPY ROOM FOR INTERVENTIONS ON LEARNING DISABILITIES (LD) AND AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER (ASD)

AN OVERVIEW OF THE PROPOSAL

Niraivagam - Don Bosco Institute of Psychological Services, a pioneer in psychological, social, spiritual and educational development, is initiating to offer a comprehensive training programme and interventions focused on enhancing the educational experience and support for students struggling with Learning Disabilities (LD) and Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). The programme will include interventions and training sessions designed for both students and teachers. **The primary aim is to build therapy rooms and equip the therapy rooms with tools** and create an inclusive educational environment and provide remedial interventions to students with diverse learning needs while empowering parents and teachers with the knowledge, skills and strategies to facilitate effective learning.

Students with LD and ASD often face unique challenges in the traditional classroom setting. This programme seeks to identify and address these challenges, promoting a supportive and adaptive learning atmosphere and training. Niraivagam's initiative aims to raise awareness, develop skill-building sessions and foster collaboration between educators and students, ensuring that no student is left behind due to their learning differences.

PREREQUISITES:

The Niraivagam Centre and its programme welcomes students with Learning Disabilities (LD) and Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), as well as teachers who are committed to fostering an inclusive learning environment.

For students, an enthusiasm for learning and a readiness to engage with tailored educational approaches are encouraged. For teachers, a genuine interest in developing new teaching methods and supporting diverse learners is essential. The success of this program hinges on active participation, collaboration, and the desire to create a more inclusive and supportive classroom environment. For these initiatives to be realized, well equipped therapy rooms are needed and necessary equipment should be bought in order to make the above mentioned interventions effective.

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROPOSAL

3. Promote Inclusive Education:

Foster an inclusive culture by raising awareness and educating the entire school community about the importance of inclusivity and how to create a learning environment that accommodates all students, regardless of their learning abilities.

4. Collaboration and Communication:

Establish a strong communication channel between students, teachers, parents and specialists to ensure that the needs of students with learning challenges are understood and addressed effectively. This includes building a support system that encourages collaboration.

5. Develop Individualized Learning Plans (ILPs):

The equipment and resources will guide teachers in designing and implementing ILPs tailored to the specific needs of students with LD and Autism, helping them to personalize the learning process and measure progress more accurately.

OUTCOMES OF THE PROPOSAL

1. Improved Learning Outcomes for Students with LD and Autism:

Students will experience enhanced academic performance, emotional well-being and engagement in school as a result of the individualized support and teaching strategies

provided by their teachers. Over the academic year, students will be better equipped to handle their learning challenges and show measurable improvement in their educational outcomes through the interventions received.

2. Increased Teacher Competency and Confidence:

Teachers will be better prepared to address the needs of students with learning challenges, adopting a more effective learning environment. The training will improve their competency in identifying learning difficulties early on and applying appropriate interventions, ensuring that all students receive the necessary support.

Parents will be trained and will be more involved in their child's learning journey and better informed about how to support their children at home. This collaborative effort will create a network of support that extends beyond the classroom.

BUDGET
